Instructions and Information

The Project has a large staff and needs to be correct in its procedures in order that the whole expedition is not penalized by bureaucratic delays. The following notes are intended to clarify and assist all prospective expedition members.

The Security Application form must be completed by every member of the field party every year and submitted by the expedition to the Supreme Council of Antiquities (SCA).

1. The permit is submitted before the end of May each year for the following winter. This date will be announced and strictly adhered to. The entire expedition must make a single submission for all the members together. Late-comers will not be permitted to join the field camp.

3. All applications **must** be accompanied by eight passport photos, a photocopy of the "information pages" of the passport, and a short (1-2 pages) C.V. of the applicant. Failure to supply these causes delay and additional expense. **Applications without copies of a valid passport will not be accepted**.

The C.V. should show the applicant's suitability to the field work intended. A couple of pages ought to be quite adequate to describe field experience and educational background. Please omit irrelevant experience ("bartender" and the like).

4 If the applicant's passport will expire before a date three months after the end of the season, it will not be acceptable to the SCA, and must be renewed before arrival in Egypt. If there is a passport change between the filing of the security application and the arrival of the applicant in Egypt, both passports must be available in Cairo for presentation to the Security Police.

5 "Forenames" means the applicant's first and middle names as they appear in the passport.

6 "Passport number & Date" means the number, date of issue and expiry date.

7 The question "Previous Visits to Egypt (Specify date & purpose of visit)" requires only the last time and it will be helpful also to give the name of the project if you were part of one (e.g., Mons Claudianus Project, 1990).

8 For the question which asks "Occupation/Position" please try to AVOID the use of 'student'; say "research assistant" instead.

Drivers. Please note that all people intending or expecting to drive the Project's vehicles must obtain an International Driving Permit, which should be accompanied by their national license. The I.D.P. can only be obtained in the country where you are regularly licensed to drive.
